

Royal Sutton Coldfield Town Council Code of Conduct

REGISTER OF COUNCILLORS INTERESTS

As a Member of Royal Sutton Coldfield Town Council ("the Council") you are required to register certain interests (known as "disclosable pecuniary interests") of your own and of your partner. These interests are set out in the table below.

When you are present at a meeting of the Council and you have a disclosable pecuniary interest (**which includes your own interest and that of your partner**) in any matter being considered which is entered in the Council's register of interests, you do not need to disclose it to the meeting, but you will withdraw from the meeting room when the matter is being discussed and will not participate, or participate further, in any discussion of, or any vote taken on, the matter at the meeting.

If your disclosable pecuniary interest (**which includes your own interest and that of your partner**) is not entered in the Council's register of interests, you will disclose its existence and, unless it is a sensitive interest, its nature, to the meeting and will notify the Monitoring Officer of the interest within 28 days of the meeting. You will withdraw from the meeting room when the matter is being discussed and will not participate, or participate further, in any discussion of, or any vote taken on, the matter at the meeting.

Pecuniary Interests

Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation:

Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain by you or your partner.

Sponsorship

Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the Council) made or provided within the relevant period in respect of any expenses incurred by you in carrying out your duties as a member, or towards your election expenses.

This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.

ROYAL SUTTON COLDFIELD CONSERVATIVE ASSOCIATION.

Contracts

Any contract which is made between you or your partner (or a body in which you or your partner has a beneficial interest) and the Council;

(a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and

(b) which has not been fully discharged.

Land

Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the Council.

Licences

Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the Council for a month or longer.

Corporate tenancies

Any tenancy where (to your knowledge);
(a) the landlord is the Council; and
(b) the tenant is a body in which you or your partner
has a beneficial interest.

Securities

Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where;

(a) that body (to your knowledge) has a place of
business or land in the area of the Council; and

(b) either;

(i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds
£25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share
capital of that body; or

(ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one
class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one
class in which you or your partner has a beneficial
interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share
capital of that class.

Any organisation of which you are a member or in a position of general control or management. Any organisation to which you are appointed or nominated by Royal Sutton Coldfield Town Council.
